MISC. UPDATES:

- The utility aggregation for electric and gas passed last week on the ballot so therefore the village will proceed with the process to provide an aggregated rate for both electric and gas (separate programs) that will likely take affect in a few months. If you are not on a current contract you will receive a letter sometime in June regarding the process, the rate and the ability to opt-out of the program if you so wish.
