As everyone has likely experienced, the Sewer Separation Project has begun on Boundary Street. The work is currently being done in the section from N. Wayne St. to N. Elm St. which is also State Route 49. There is currently an ODOT detour for SR 49 and we ask everyone to avoid using this street to ensure everyone's safety. Residents traveling to the Post Office and Wayne IGA will need to utilize Broadway St. & St Clair St. Once the work is completed on the westernmost block, we will reopen that up for access to the IGA parking lot only. This stage will likely take 4-5 weeks to complete and we will reopen the highway as quickly as possible. At a later date, State Route 119 will be closed from William/3rd Street intersection out to FR-Minster Road for a few weeks. Access to Hull Bros and VonderHaars Processing Plant will be from the east during construction in this area. We are in the final stages of the overall Sewer Separation Plan as required by the Ohio EPA and appreciate everyone's cooperation and patience during this lengthy process.

The Village is currently working on a park project to replace the aged playground equipment at Community Park. The current set was built in 1984 and has served the village very well but it is time to replace due to safety and accessibility concerns along with a general update to the activities available. Thus far we have received some generous support from the Psi Iota Xi Sorority, Fort Recovery Community Foundation, Jubilee Committee, Fort Recovery Bowling Association and the Community Club for which we are very grateful and will allow us to complete a very nice improvement to our park system. We will be determining the final plan here in the next few weeks so that the order can be completed and installation will occur late this summer.

We again appreciate everyone's patience as we worked to get Ambassador Pool up and running this summer. The maintenance crew did a great job of locating and repairing the large leaks allowing the pool to open on May 29th. We do have one more leak that has been located and will be repaired on Wednesday, June 3rd requiring the pool to be closed for the day. If all goes as planned this should put our facility in good shape for the remainder of the summer and hopefully for many more years!

Don't forget about the upcoming Jubilee on June 19-22. Presale ride tickets are available along with raffle and 50/50 tickets. As always the committee has a great agenda planned and the support from the community is tremendous. We hope you will bring the family and come out and enjoy another great Jubilee event!!
