The Sewer Separation Project continues to progress very well with much of the underground work completed in the area between N. Wayne St and N. Elm St. (St Rt 49). The crews from Tom's Construction are doing a great job! Residents traveling to the Post Office and Wayne IGA can access both from Boundary Street until the paving crews show up here in the next few weeks. Once the paving work is completed we will reopen this section and move on east on Boundary Street. Again we appreciate everyone's patience and cooperation as we work through this project

The Village Council also approved the purchase of the replacement playground equipment in Community Park. What a great improvement this will make for our park system! We are still working with a few groups on some final funding and will make the final decision on the surfacing in the next few weeks. We anticipate installation during August/September of this year.
