With Milligan Street designated as a truck route from SR 49 to Wayne Street we want to make sure we look at all issues before making any decision. The village has ordered the new playground equipment for Community Park and is looking at a mid-August installation date. We are still working to raise some final funds to complete the surfacing of the new area with a poured rubberized surface and hope to make that final decision soon. This will be a great improvement for our parks and we appreciate everyone who has provided funding for the project and those that have provided input during the planning stages.
